Please...

4-*Personally* hand to Ms. Jentilet or Mr. Rose with your actual valid driver's license.

5-Attend one of the orientations.

**Who needs to apply for parking?**

Everyone. "Everyone" means every student who wants to park on campus. Everyone must reapply for the Spring Semester. This includes all students who are awarded parking spaces for the fall. *A Fall Semester Permit DOES NOT guarantee a Spring Semester space.*

**How and when do I apply?**

Blank applications will be in the main office by **May 1, 2011**. Completed applications must be handed to Mr. Rose or Ms. Jentilet by **June 15, 2011**. Do not give your application to anyone else; do not leave it anywhere. THE APPLICANT (NOT A PARENT, FRIEND, OR ANYONE ELSE) MUST HAND IT ONLY TO MR. ROSE OR MS. JENTILET. Part of the application is a copy of proof of insurance, a copy of the vehicle registration(s), and recent copy of your driver's license. Students are asked to make copies *without* the use of the office copy machines. Applications submitted after **June 15, 2011** will be accepted, but will go to the bottom of the pile.

**Who gets priority parking?**

**Priorities are set by the Board of Education and are upheld.**

- **First** priority goes to those seniors enrolled in a work experience course or internship course. Please note: "work experience" does not mean that you simply have a job; it means you are enrolled in work experience as part of your completer program to meet graduation requirements. History shows that these students will all get spots.
- **Second** priority goes to those seniors registered for Jump Start and enrollment verified by Anne Arundel Community College. The vast majority of those applying on time will get spots, but there is no guarantee. Anyone with a completed application submitted by **July 15, 2011** will be placed in a lottery. Names will be picked at random.
- **Third** priority will go to those seniors with at least a 2.0 GPA and a completed application turned in by **August 19, 2011**. Participation in after school activities gives no priority; names will be picked at random to fill the remaining front lot/Central Middle and Sojourner Douglass spaces. A space is unlikely.
- **Fourth**, complete applications submitted after **August 20, 2011** will stay on file, but the chance for a slot is remote.

**When is the deadline?**

**June 15, 2011** is a real deadline. If you are sick, forget, have an incomplete application, or are out-of-town, it is still your responsibility to get the application in Mr. Rose's or Ms. Jentilet's hands on or before **June 15, 2011**. Submit your application early to avoid complications. Do not chance waiting for the last week. **Please re-read the last sentence.**

**Who does not get priority?**

The Board of Education gives no priority for athletics, non-seniors, service to the school, or the need to travel to a job or anywhere else before school ends. We simply do not have space to accommodate all the legitimate and worthy needs of all of our students. There are 130 spaces; we will receive more than twice that number of applications. We are sorry, but we simply do not have enough spaces.

**What about parking at CAT-South or Central Middle?**

Central Middle is kind enough to allow us 20 spaces. We fill these Central Middle spaces by using the priorities listed above. CAT-South allows students enrolled in a CAT-South work study program to use spaces in their lot. CAT-South spaces should be applied for at CAT-South. Unauthorized parking at CAT-South, Central Middle, Sojourner Douglass College, or South River High may result in a towed vehicle.

**What about the required orientation class?**

**ALL STUDENTS MUST TAKE ONE ORIENTATIONS.** The orientations given in July and August are also good for the Spring. The orientation will be in the auditorium on **July 18, 2011 at 9:00 a.m., July 19, 2011 at 9:00 a.m., July 20, 2011 at 9:00 a.m., August 12, 2011 at noon, August 16, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. and August 19, 2011 at noon.** You only need to attend one of these sessions. Students late for the orientation by even a minute or two will **not** be admitted. An orientation class is required to park at South River High School, CAT-South, Sojourner Douglass College or Central Middle School. **PLEASE ADJUST YOUR SCHEDULE NOW IN ORDER TO ATTEND.**

## SOUTH RIVER PARKING AND VEHICLE RULES

### ELIGIBILITY FOR PARKING:

All students applying for a parking permit must be seniors, have earned 18 credits, and owe no student obligations. Priority will be given to students in South River work experience and internship courses. Jump Start students will be given priority over the remaining qualified seniors. All students parking on campus must complete the orientation class.

### RULES:

1. All drivers understand that falsifying information on this application is reason for revocation or denial of a permit.
2. All students agree to keep the information on their application up-to-date by reporting changes the day the changes occur (i.e. phone number, different insurance, new vehicle, dropped college courses, etc).
3. All drivers agree to drive only their registered vehicles to school.
4. All drivers agree to park **ONLY** in the gym side of the lot (past orange line) or spots marked 1 through 20 in Central Middle School parking lot.
5. All drivers agree NOT TO LEND their permit to anyone or to use someone else's parking permit.
6. All drivers agree to hang their permit on the rear view mirror the entire time the vehicle is in their school parking space.
7. All drivers agree to be on time to school. Repeated tardiness will result in a suspended or revoked permit.
8. All drivers agree to drive safely on school property.
9. All drivers agree to drive at the parking lot speed of 15 MPH or less.
10. All drivers agree to follow Maryland Motor Vehicle Laws on school property.
11. All drivers understand that on the first infraction of any safety rule the parking permit will be taken away.
12. All drivers understand that anyone who parks without a permit, or who parks in the wrong parking space may have their vehicle towed. Students are responsible for any fees and are subject to school discipline.
13. All drivers understand that the parking lot is off-limits during the school day. Students needing to go to their vehicle must acquire a pass from an administrator.
14. All drivers understand that vehicles should be removed as soon as possible at the end of the school day or activity.
15. Administrators may revoke driving privileges, tow or impose fines for breaking rules.
16. If there are no spaces in the student area (gym side of orange line in parking lot or Central Middle School allotted spaces), the driver may not park on school grounds. DO NOT park in staff parking area.
17. Progressive Discipline for Parking Violations:

Violation	Discipline
1	Warning sticker on vehicle.
2	2 <sup>nd</sup> Warning Sticker – Conference w/Student; call to parent; detention
3	3 <sup>rd</sup> Warning Sticker – Call to Parents; Letter; Conference with Parents; Warn of Suspension
4	4 <sup>th</sup> Warning Sticker – 1 day suspension from school for insubordination
5	5 <sup>th</sup> Warning Sticker – 2 day suspension for insubordination; Vehicle towed.
6	6 <sup>th</sup> and subsequent Warning Stickers – 3 or more day suspension for insubordination; Vehicle towed.

**Once approved for parking, there will be a \$15.00 parking fee per semester to defray costs.

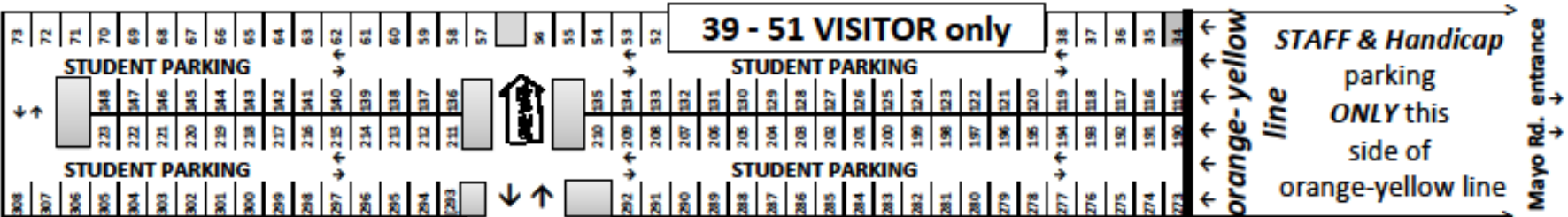
